The Brownsville Junior Service League is an organization committed to helping families, women, and children of the community. The League will select six students from the list of viable candidates to be the recipients of scholarship monies.

Qualifications:

- Applicant must be a current high school student graduating in the 2018-2019 school year and a resident of the city of Brownsville.
- Student must have applied to at least two universities and accepted to at least one (submit letter of acceptance from university).
- Student must maintain at least an 87 Scholastic GPA throughout all of the years in high school.
- Student must submit current high school transcript and two recommendation letters.
- Student must have completed at least 100 hours of community service during his or her high school years. Proof of volunteer hours from the location or point of contact need to be submitted.

Guidelines:

- Applicant must be a **current/ passing** student for the August 2018 – June 2019 school year.
- Recipient will be awarded and notified of the scholarship no later than March 20, 2019.
- All application information will only be used by the Brownsville Junior Service League to determine the candidates who will be awarded the scholarship.
- All information submitted will not be shared with anyone outside the league. The scholarship review committee will maintain strict confidentiality protocols to protect applicant’s personal information.
- All applications will be evaluated on a non-discriminatory basis with no regard to age, race, ethnicity, or creed.

Please Note: Proper documentation and a fully completed application are required to be considered for review by the leagues scholarship review committee.

- Fill out application. (Mark N/A where appropriate)
- Sign and date the application.
- Attach all necessary documentation.
- Applicants are required to **write an essay answering the following questions:**

(2 page limit, typed, Times New Roman, 12 font)

1. How did your volunteer service work impact the community of Brownsville?
2. Please include a short summary of your educational plans and goals?
3. What awards, recognitions, or certificates do you hold and how did you earn them?
